

Each month we see a steady stream of new people come into the church and it seems like **someone receives Christ nearly every week through one these ministries**. I'm amazed to say that we have **baptized 40+ believers** and there are still more signed up for baptism before year end.

Last year God put a vision into my wife's heart to start a women's ministry. She spent nearly the entire year simply working on discipling and training a small leadership team. This year in February they started their first monthly conference/event. It has been amazing to see how they decorate, invite, and prepare every detail and how passionate the are about ministering to the needs of women in our community. Every month over 50 women gather to leave their hurts



at the foot of the cross and learn how to Trust in the Father again. It has become the expectation to have several new women receive Christ every month! Many of them are now attending the church and even bringing their families.

For years we struggled with building a healthy worship team. Finding talent, or bringing in talented people that didn't align with our church culture and leadership always seemed to be a problem. However, this year God gave us the idea to build our own talent farm. We started offering music and media classes to 10-16 year old's in our church and community. After 6 months of classes, we hand selected 12 teens to become a part of our School of worship. Every week they meet to learn



music, as well as biblical principles to form a heart that worships the Lord in Spirit and in Truth. I am excited to say that my oldest two sons (Santi and Caleb) both are a part of this team! Continue to pray for their spiritual growth as the teens now lead worship for both our Saturday and Sunday services.







Instituto FDV

After 9 years in Peru and many struggles to form stable leaders, we realized that a customized approach was needed. We formed an Instituto where we teach three tracks; spiritual growth, personal growth, and professional growth. These classes have been a source for centralized discipleship where we have seen over 30 adults become more established this year.



We plan to make this a key stepping stone for all believers that desire to grow into leadership.

Outreach

Christmas time is coming! In Peru that means one of our best opportunities for evangelistic outreaches. Last year we were able to reach out to 3 local communities and give gifts to over 700 children as well as preach the gospel to their families. This year we plan to reach two neighborhoods

in our community, take a team to the Andes mountains to reach an unreached village, as well as support our missionaries works on the amazon river. We are even supporting one of our pastors (Jose Manuel Estrado) to travel to Venezuela to do a similar outreach project in his hometown!
